TOPAZ MOUNTAIN

According to Bureau of Land Management, Topaz, Utah's state gem, is a semi-precious gemstone that occurs as very hard, transparent crystals in a variety of colors. The topaz crystals at Topaz Mountain are naturally amber colored but become colorless after extensive exposure to sunlight. The crystals formed within cavities of the Topaz Mountain rhyolite, a volcanic rock which erupted approximately six to seven million years ago from volcanic vents along faults in the area. Topaz Mountain is one of the world's great places to find topaz. If you search the washes and slopes on the south side of the mountain you will find small topaz crystals glimmering in the sunlight. If you search seams in the rhyolite, you may find gem-quality crystals. Topaz Mountain is located in a remote area where there is no water and no services provided. You should always carry food, plenty of water, tools and emergency equipment. To dig the topaz, helpful tools include a rock hammer or regular hammer, screw driver, bags for your gems, hiking boots, hat, sunscreen, bug repellant and

once again don't forget the water! Jeans are a wise choice since while your digging you are often on your knees on the rough and jagged rocks. Most importantly, while digging and searching for this gem, have fun. Most everyone who searches and digs for this gem will find some, with patients and a lot of hammering and prying.

PRESIDENTS CORNER

This year there are some changes that we need to make sure everyone understands. As a board we have decided that we are going to align our election terms with our budget year and RFL Donation. What that means is our budget is set to run from October 1st through September 31st . To ensure that any newly elected Board/Officers are involved in that budgetary process, our terms of office will be changed from January 1st to October 1st . The elected term will then run from October 1st (of the elected year) to September 31st two years after.
