



2024 Ride Schedule with Update Lodging & Staging Information

The 2024 ride schedule is here. We have updated the rides to include known or best guess information so you can start planning to join us while still being able to make plans to camp or have time for lodging reservations. January 20th: Delle

Staging at 9am. Riders Meeting at 9:45, Departing at 10am. We will be staging in the parking lot immediately West of the Delle City Station (Sinclair gas station) in Delle. Delle is 51 miles West of Salt Lake City. Put, "Delle City Station" or "delle, ut" into your maps and it will get you there.

February 16th & 17th: Joshua Tree/Castle Cliff (St. George)

February's ride will be in the St. George area on the 16th and 17th. Exact start times will be determined as we get closer. On Friday we will stage out of Gunlock State Park. The ride will be about 53 miles and rated as easy. It should be scenic desert riding. The Club BBQ will follow.

On Saturday, we will stage out of Bloomington at Bear Claw Trailhead. We will depart at 9am sharp! This ride will be about 100 miles so bring extra gas, but is rated as easy. This will be scenic desert riding as we travel west towards Beaver Dam. For those camping at Gunlock ONLY, a separate closer staging area (20 miles away) will be provided and the Bear Claw staging group will meet you there at 9:30am. We will meet you at: 37°01'35.7"N 113°54'24.5"W You will need to be street legal to travel from Gunlock to this alternate staging area. For those staying in hotels— use the Bear Claw Trailhead for staging!

There is an array of hotel and camping options based on people's preferences all within a short drive for trailering.

March 16th: Silver Island Mtn. (Wendover)

This will be a day ride near Wendover, UT. Specific staging times and routes will be determined in the next few weeks. If you want to, spending the night in Wendover is an option.

April 19th & 20th: San Rafael Swell (Green River)

April's club ride will be occurring April 19th and 20th in the San Rafael Swell. Staging will occur immediately south of the interstate on Exit 131. This is about 30 miles west of Green River. There will be free BLM camping options near the staging area and the nearest hotels will be 30 miles away in Green River. Exact staging times will be posted as we get closer.

May 17th & 18th: Kanab

May's club ride will be occurring May 17th and 18th in the Kanab area. Staging is anticipated to occur near the Crocodile/Johnson trailhead. From the Kanab Visitor Center (BLM), travel east on Highway 89 for 8.6 miles. Turn left onto Johnson Canyon Road. Follow Johnson Canyon Road for 7.8 miles before reaching the anticipated trailhead on the left-hand side of the road. There are paid and BLM camping options in the area near the trailhead. Lodging options will be best in Kanab. Once the exact staging area is identified, the website and Facebook will be updated.

June 15th: Fairview/Skyline Drive; Arapeen Trail

This will be a day ride and will stage at the large snowmobile parking lot at the top of Fairview Canyon. It is approximately 73 miles from Sandy, UT and will take about 1.5 hours travel time due to driving up the canyon road. This ride will be about 80-90 miles, but generally rated as easy and scenic!

July 19th & 20th: Fishlake

This ride will be staging at Fish Lake Day One. The exact location will be determined later. The first days ride (19th) will occur around the Fish Lake forest area. Day Two (20th) will stage out of Koosharem (16 miles from Fish Lake). Street legal machine can ride from the campsite to Koosharem. Day Two we'll ride from Koosharem over to Richfield and back. There is public BLM camping in the area as well as cabin/RV spots are reserved at www.fishlakeresorts.com. There are hotels in Loa (25 minute drive), Bicknell (36 min drive), and Richfield (46 min. drive).

August 23rd & 24th: Panguitch

This will be staging at the Henrie's Hitch-N-Post RV Resort in Panguitch. There are camping options there as well as an array of hotel lodging options close by in town.

September 7th: 50" ONLY; Gooseberry System

This will be a day ride.

September 28th & 29th: Ride for Life (Wendover)

There will be much more information forth coming about the 40th Annual Ride for Life event this year.

October 19th: Marjum Pass (Delta)

This will be a day ride staging west of Delta near the U-Dig Fossil Quarry. This is about 168 miles from Sandy and will take approximately 3 hours to travel to. If you choose, Delta has an array of hotel options and the staging site will have free BLM camping options.

November 9th: 5-Mile to Eureka

This will be a day ride, staging on the southwest parking lot of the 5-Mile Pass recreation area near the Pony Express
