A Look Back at the Kanab Ride in May

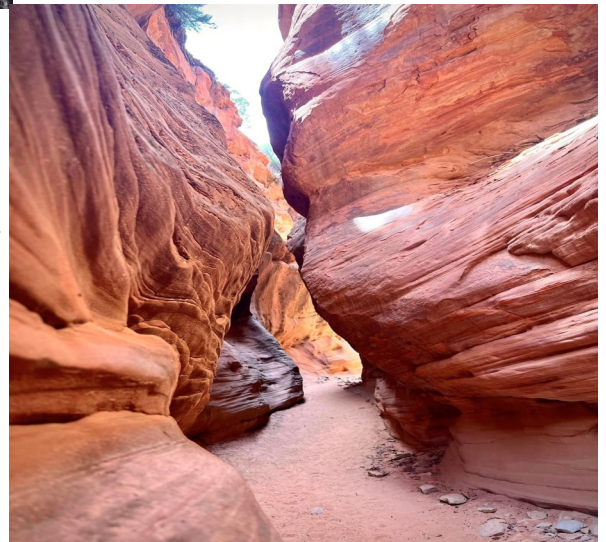

Living in the desert we shouldn't complain about having too much water, so we won't. However, due to all the snow still along Skyline Drive (south) trail, we have changed the location for our June ride. Finding a route where we won't get stuck in the snow has kept things at a lower elevation.

We will be riding out of Ephraim. This will take us at a mid-mountain route towards Manit and back. There will be lots of green, Aspen groves, wildflowers, water, and expect mud. Based on available open trails we will travel between 40-60 miles.

We will be staging at the Snow College West Campus parking area. As you come into town on Main Street, follow this to the Maverick and turn right on 100 N. Go west about 3 blocks and you will see the Campus building on your left. We will be in the large parking lot behind the building. The closest cross-road is 100 N. 400 W. Just look for the Club trailer.

For the Club bbq after we will meet at the staging area and have the bbq there. Bring your lawn chairs and a shade tent along with a side dish to share! It will be a great time!
