Summer Riding Safety Part II

Last month we reviewed several ideas and suggestions to help everyone enjoy the summer riding season safely by:

- 1. Wearing the appropriate clothing
- 2. Staying hydrated, and
- 3. Resting often

Aside from these simple tips, what are some suggestions that the experts who ride suggest we carry with us to enjoy the summer riding season safely? Here's a few suggestions that they made:

- 1. Good leather gloves
- 2. Good footwear (especially if you are getting out and hiking around)
- 3. Having a dust mask
- 4. Rain gear. **August starts the mountain monsoon season**
- Wearing thin pants helps keep you cool and protected from the sun.
- 6. A backpack, just in case you have to walk you can then carry needed items.
- 7. A fire extinguisher

Another common discussion point was being very aware of where you park your machine and to avoid tall grass that could start a fire due to the heat of the machine.

All good things to consider for safe and enjoyable trips.
